

Intercepted Signs

was going to give you the key to finding the ascendant on your past-life chart, presuming you're lucky enough to know your past life birthday, but to my surprise, I stumbled onto something else instead. Intercepted signs.

An intercepted sign is a sign that does not fall on any house cusp. The house starts with a late degree of one sign, has all 30 degrees of the next sign inside it, and finally ends several degrees into the third sign. I had previously speculated that such a house had two distinct "stories", or delineations. The first, the sign on the cusp was what should be, but largely wasn't, partly because the degree was late & so the sign exhausted, but mostly because there was a parasite (intercepted sign) lurking inside it. That sign constitutes a "make-do" that you're not quite aware of until it's pointed out to you. I still think that works, especially if the intercepted sign is not tenanted, i.e., there's no planet in the sign.

But in analyzing my own intercepted Saturn in Libra in the 5th, I found compelling reasons (too involved to go into here) to believe the four children I had in my most immediate past life were not mine. In this life I remember as a small child, less than five years old, before I knew or suspected anything, that I did NOT want to marry, and I did NOT want children. It is my opinion that such childish thoughts are hangovers from the previous life, as I know of no other explanation for them.

So I am now exploring the idea that intercepted signs are dysfunctions from the immediate past life. In the past week, two examples have arrived.

By accident I was directed to a page with the chart of an English magician (the real kind, not the stage juggler), born January 8, 1953, 1:30 am, Goring by Sea, England. Here we have Sun intercepted in Capricorn in the 3rd, Saturn on the ascendant in Libra, and the Moon in the 12th. In this life, the man is said to be a recluse. Looking at the interception, with Saturn on the ascendant & ruling the intercepted Sun, I had the strongest impression of a reincarnate fugitive. Someone who was hiding in his own community (3rd house is local), someone known to the authorities (Sun disposed by Saturn), someone whose very face was known to all (Saturn on the ascendant), but who escaped capture. Moon in the 12th was another indicator.

On Monday I had a call from a woman curious about her 5th house Saturn. Turns out she had intercepted signs (I forget which) in the 1st and 7th. I had just finished delineating a chart with an erroneous time that gave interceptions in 1 & 7, so I pounced.

Interception in the first, there was a past life where she wasn't "seen" for who she really was (1st). As a consequence, there was an arranged marriage with a man who had no interest in her as a wife (7th). So, when she gave him children (5th), they weren't hers, but her husband's. Perhaps they were taken away from her, perhaps she felt guilty about having them, there are things that I just can't guess, but the net result was a pair of interceptions & Saturn in the 5th.


I stress the interceptions I've seen were all tenanted, in other words, there were planets lurking in them. Also, in every case, there was some controlling planet or house elsewhere in the chart which, by aspect, or rulership, or just because it was appropriate, was the source of the problem, or provided the outcome, or both.

A few months ago I reviewed a **book by Alice Miller** that claimed intercepted houses made the individual somehow "special", unique & gifted, an idea I found silly. For one thing, the further north you go, the more signs get intercepted. In India interceptions are quite rare. In Scotland, it's exactly the reverse. And now here I am, claiming that interceptions make you dysfunctional.

Could it be that we all started out in equatorial Gardens of Eden & as we made mistake after mistaeke, our penance was to be born, ever more gifted, in ever colder climes? Is our fate to be Nordic reindeer herding geniuses? Will our Ultimate Destination be as an interior decorator in that famous Ice Hotel?

I think it more likely the chart finds ways to give us what we need to experience, and that when it has interceptions to work with, it does so. Now: The past life ascendant.

I have a friend, JES, who was born November 17, 1956, 5:08 pm, NYC. His most immediate past life, as a soldier, ended early in WWII. As is typical of soldiers who die young, he came roaring back (**Stephen Crane**), and that's the part that's confused me. He was previously JPS, born in Germany on February 20, 1745. So what's the 1745 ascendant? Maybe in a week it will appear to me.



Part 41: More Hollday Cheer! MAKING A WILL, 2

N the case of a will made in emergency during illness, the following rules should be observed. If the Moon be slow in motion, unaspected, combust, or under the Sunbeams, the testator will die & the will remain unaltered. This is especially so if the Moon be in conjunction (not in aspect) to Mars, provided Mars is not in the ascendant nor aspecting either the ascendant or its lord. There is, however, danger that the will will be lost or stolen.

If Saturn, instead of Mars, is similarly placed in regard to the Moon or lord of the ascendant, the testator will live & the will remain unaltered during the rest of his life & after his death; but if Saturn afflict the ascendant, it will be altered.

If Jupiter or Venus be similarly placed the testator will recover, and subsequently revoke the will. — **Electional Astrology**, 1937

Venus in the Houses

In First House: Addicted to flirting. Danger of seduction if afflicted. Often delays marriage.

In Second House: May marry for money, or marry a rich partner after some delay. Partner will not be happy on account of the native's neglect, jealousy, or exacting demands.

In Third House: Danger of entanglements & of seduction if afflicted, but sometimes gives monastic tastes. Love affairs on a voyage, and marriage or union abroad or while traveling.

In Fourth House: Unstable love affairs. Danger of seduction & adultery. Loss of position through a love affair. Strange events in love & marriage. Unreturned affection on the part of the native or the partner.

<u>In Fifth House</u>: Inclined to be jealous & self-indulgent. Precocious & dangerous love affairs. Fortunate marriage.

In Sixth House: Many troubles in love; attachments to inferiors; and a partner of low birth or social position. Unhappy marriage. Danger of impotence or venereal diseases.

In Seventh House: Native attracted to loose women. Marriage sometimes delayed & sometimes early, but if Scorpio or Capricorn an irregular union may be formed. More than one marriage.

In Eighth House: Exacting affections. Danger of troubles in love & seduction, and loss of property through women. Marriage may be delayed, and may bring financial gain, followed by the death of the partner, or separation & divorce. — Astrology & Sex, 1941

Forecasting the Length of Life

THEN you look carefully at the Giver of Life, that is, the ruler of the chart, and you see in what house it is located, and in what kind of sign, and in what degrees, and you also consider the ruler of the sign in which the Life-Giver is situated, in what sign & in what house and in what degree it is, and to what extent the Giver of Life & the benefic planets are aspected to the Sun & Moon, you will easily be able to delineate the whole character of this life. For, if the Life-Giver is situated in a good house, in a good sign and in good degrees, a healthy number of years is portended, especially if Jupiter in a diurnal nativity, or Venus in a nocturnal nativity, is in favorable aspect to the Giver of Life.

If Saturn is the Giver of Life & is favorable, he decrees 57 years, but if he portends evil he decrees 30 years, or 30 months & 12 hours.

If Jupiter is the Giver of Life & is favorable, he decrees 79 years, but if unfavorable 12 years, or 12 months & 12 days & 12 hours.

If Mars is the Life-Giver & is favorable, he portends 63 years; if unfavorable 15 years, or 15 months, 15 days & 12 hours.

If the Sun is favorable he decrees 120 years; if unfavorable 18 years; if moderate 45 years.

Venus, if she decrees favorably, 84 years; if unfavorably 8 years, 8 days, 12 hours.

Mercury, if he decrees favorably, 108 years; if moderately 79 years; if unfavorably 20 years, or 29 months, 20 days, 20 hours.

If the Moon decrees favorably, 84 years; if unfavorably 25 years.

If the Ruler of Life is in his own house or in his own exaltation or in his own terms, and if planets in his own condition exert a favorable influence on him, then a larger number of years is portended.
