Fish Stolen

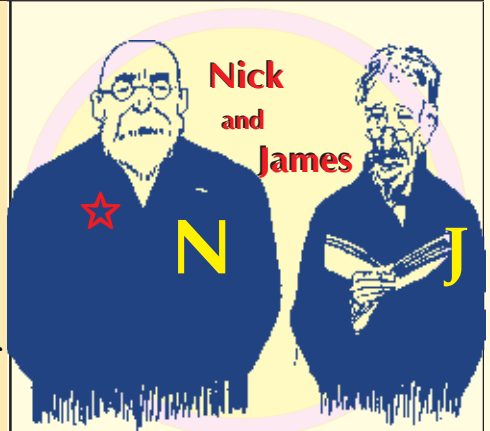

The Ruler of the Horoscope

IF Aries or Scorpio is on the Ascendant, Mars is the native's dynamic guide for life, setting an example of indomitable will, independence & energy that will be required in the environments to which the native will be led. It may be a troubled life and certainly active, with need for fortitude. If Aries, quick to anger & quickly over: if Scorpio slow to anger & never forgotten – which affects this contacts; if Scorpio, the native rarely leaves off his armor & likes to retire within it. There will be rashness leading to failures, accidents or surgery, due to taking on more than he can handle.

All 1st & 8th House matters are important & come up as major incidents sooner or later. There is an inopportune death or divorce in the family, upsetting the whole environmental pattern with the guide disposed to let the native battle it out by himself, having equipped him to do just that. The mate will be easy to get along with (the 7th ruled by Venus) though there may be one major separation or divorce, and a period of financial stringency. Intercepted Signs & Reincarnation

I have puzzled out that intercepted signs amount to where you were a victim of abuse in a past life. This gets us into Victimology & there's a rather large body of literature on that subject already. Since co-dependency & abuse can get explosive in a hurry, I need to start with some ground rules.

Beginning with the definition of "intercepted signs". Intercepted signs are signs of the zodiac which do not appear on any house cusp. Just so we're all on the same page.

FIRST, you need an accurately timed chart. Yes, two quadrants of your horoscope are going to be bigger than the other two, no matter what time of day you were born, but the pair of houses that have intercepted signs in them are dependent on the exact time. Interceptions in 1 & 7 are very different than interceptions in 3 & 9. If I'm not mistaken, many of you who have interceptions will go ballistic when you read my preliminary delineations, so it's important you've got the right chart in front of you.

In this regard, the time on your birth certificate IS NOT ACCURATE unless it's been PROVEN ACCURATE. And I am the example. A transcription error turned 12:52 pm into 12:32 pm (5 misread as 3). I subsequently rectified it to 12:47. In my case, the difference was interceptions in 6 & 12, instead of 5 & 11. In other words, for 25 years I had a chart which I myself could not read. That's what a time error will do.

SECOND, You must use PLACIDUS, or its near cousin, Topocentric. NONE other. Koch, for example, gives me interceptions in 4 & 10. Other house systems have other uses. This isn't one of them.

THIRD, One or both of the intercepted signs must be TENANTED. The two intercepted signs must have at least ONE PLANET between them. So what if you have interceptions but there's no planets in them? Simple. You're Over It. It was Long Ago. It's No Big Deal. It's Done & Finished. It's Old News. It's Ho-Hum. — Get the idea?

FOURTH, Proper delineation requires synthesis of the signs, houses, planets, aspects & dispositors involved. If you never got beyond reading it out of a book, you're not going to get terribly far with interceptions, though you will get something.

The results are just awful. I hate myself for figuring this out. Here goes:

Interceptions in 1 & 7 are a past life as a

slave (1) or as chattel (7). In both cases, you were not seen as who you actually were (ascendant), as a result, you were either a nobody (slave) or were sold in marriage (chattel). Also here are those who have no name, who lose their identity. In his next life's chart, **Mozart** will be here, as his identity was lost.

Interceptions in 2 & 8 have to do with property. If the emphasis is in 2, you came from a place where you had no possessions, you were destitute. If in 8, you were forced to borrow in order to survive.

Interceptions in 3 & 9 were fugitives (3) or refugees (9).

Interceptions in 4 & 10 was a life as a prisoner (4) or held to public ridicule (10)

Interceptions in 5 & 11 have to do with children (they weren't yours, that's why you're indifferent now) and/or friends who weren't true (11).

Six & 12 are confinement in a large camp (12) or forcibly drafted into an army (6). A past life as soldier on the Russian front qualifies as 6, while death in a German or Japanese labor camp qualifies as 12. As soldiers & camp laborers are often young adults, people who die in such situations often reincarnate quickly, often in less than 20 years, sometimes in as little as five. Anorexia is a possible current life consequence (12), as are vivid memories.

I just shocked myself. I know a man who is most likely a reincarnate WWII German soldier. Reliving that has been his whole life as long as I've known him, and that's nearly 30 years. So I peeked just now at his chart. Interceptions in 6 & 12! Intercepted Scorpio in 6 with Sun, Venus, Jupiter & Neptune in it. Intercepted Mars in Taurus in 12 opposing & disposing it all, irritates it out of him, but keeps it a secret from all but close friends. I've had his chart for 20 years, but before this moment I had never looked at the interceptions.

Intercepted planets have dispositors, and intercepted planets rule house cusps. These can be tricky. In my case, Jupiter intercepted in Aries in 11 rules Sag on my 7th: My false friends belonged to my wife. In another case, Sun in Capricorn, intercepted in 3, was ruled by Saturn in Libra on the ascendant. Sun in 3, a fugitive. Saturn disposing, the law was after him. On his ascendant, they knew who he was (1) & where (3), but, Sun intercepted, could not put their hands (i.e., a cusp) on him.

Real astrology has teeth in it. It is fascinating to see it in motion.

ELECTIONAL ASTROLOGY

Part 43: Business & Occupation

Apprenticing a Youth to trade

Fortify the Moon, the cusp of the tenth house, and the lord of the tenth in the radical & electional maps. Fortify also the planet ruling the trade selected, and the signs influencing it, as given in all the text-books of natal astrology.

Learning Any Trade or Occupation

Note the planet ruling the occupation & let one of the signs ruled by that planet occupy the ascendant or tenth house.

Learning Any Science

Place a human sign upon the ascendant & let the Moon be in a human sign also. Put the lord of the ascendant in the tenth or entering it, and the lords of the tenth & ninth in aspect to the ascendant. Let the Moon be in conjunction with Mercury or in good aspect to it, Mercury being strong & well-dignified. Put Mercury in good aspect with the lord of the ascendant; and let the lord of the ninth be in reception with the lord of the ascendant. See that the Moon is not decreasing in light nor descending in latitude.

Aphorisms from Astrology and Sex by Vivian Robson

G. Trouble through love & marriage.

114. Marriage, and other matters of a natural or legal character, suffer hindrances from the malefics; but matters of an unnatural or illegal character, are hindered by the benefics.

115. In a woman's horoscope the Sun afflicted by Uranus indicates elopement or seduction, or prevents marriage. If at the same time Mars afflicts the Moon or Venus, seduction is seriously threatened.

116. When Venus is powerfully situated, but in the sign or exaltation of a malefic, inconveniences are to be feared from unlawful loves.

117. When Venus is badly placed & afflicted by a weak & unfortunate Mars the native will suffer a world of mischief & troubles by means of love.

H. Details concerning the native.

118. If both luminaries are in masculine signs in men's nativities, their actions will be natural; but if so placed in women's nativities their actions will be masculine. Mars & Venus, if matutine, incline to masculinity; and if vespertine, to femininity.

119. Take notice in the nativity of a man, whether Sun and Moon be both in masculine signs, or both in one masculine quarter or one masculine sign; for if so, it signifies that the native's acts & temper shall be naturally such as belong to men. But in a woman's nativity, the luminaries so disposed, makes a kind of virago, one that shall despise men, and obtrude herself into their affairs, and such a one, if she marry, will be sure to wear the breeches. — *Astrology & Sex*, by Vivian Robson, 1941

PTOLEMY'S TETRABIBLOS

From the Centiloquy

XXI. When the Moon may be in Scorpio or Pisces, purgation may be advantageously used, provided the lord of the ascendant be coupled with some star posited below the earth. If he be coupled with a star placed above the earth, the potion swallowed will be vomited up.

XXII. Neither put on nor lay aside any garment for the first time, when the Moon may be located in Leo. And it will be still worse to do so, should she be badly affected.

XXIII. Aspects between the Moon & stars give the native much activity; and, if the stars be in power, they indicate an efficient, but if weak an inert, excitation to action.

XXIV. An eclipse of the luminaries, if in the angles of the nativity, or an annual revolution, is noxious; and the effects take place according to the space between the ascendant & the time of the eclipse. And as, in a solar eclipse, a year is reckoned for an hour, so likewise, in a lunar eclipse, a month is reckoned for an hour.

XXV. The progression of a significator, posited in the mid-heaven, is to be made by right ascension; of another posited in the ascendant, by the oblique ascension of the particular latitude.

XXVI. There is obvious concealment in the case, if the star significative of any particular affair be in conjunction with the Sun, either under the earth or in a place foreign to its own nature. On the other hand, there is manifestation, should the star be raised to elevation out of its depression, and be located in its own place.
