

arol J took me to task for promoting Sabians. I don't like them much either, I said, but they make a nice foil for Charubel. Then I remembered that Robert Blaschke, in Astrology, A Language of Life vol. 5, Holographic Transits, discovered or invented a unique use for Sepharial's contribution to that book (Degrees of the Zodiac Analyzed).

According to Blaschke, the picture for your prenatal eclipse, from Sepharial's **La Volasfera**, gives a unique picture of you & your life. He gives George W. Bush's prenatal, at 7 degrees of Cancer:

An iron gauntlet, a sword, and a scourge lying together upon the stump of a tree. It indicates a person of strong personality, but of a tyrannous nature, who, by force of arms & aggression generally, will press forward regardless of the merits of others & insensible of their feelings. His hand, though strong, is frequently unjust & cruel in its action, impelled by the motive that "might is right"; and, when opposed, is capable of extreme cruelty & selfishness. In certain natures the influence of this degree generates the common-place "bully". It is a degree of **Self Assertion**. (Sepharial, pg. 69; Blaschke, pg. 36)

## Here is Obama's at 27 Aquarius:

A stately mansion surrounded by trees in an expanse of pastureland. This symbol denotes one who will be "house proud," fond of his home & desirous of acquiring estate, so he may have the uninterrupted joys of continuous home life. He will prove himself to be a capable and polished member of society, a good patriot, and an earnest upholder of the traditions of his people and country. Of a pleasant and frank nature, and humane disposition, he will readily attract friends around him, and will be never so happy as when entertaining them in a homely but unostentatious manner. He will prosper in the world and will be beloved for his breadth of mind and wide sympathies. It is a degree of possession.

But, you will say, this isn't individual

at all. Everyone born between two solar eclipses would be the same!

Which is exactly right. The period between two solar eclipses defines all those born between the two dates. Which implies that everyone born between June 29 and November 22, 1946, are essentially bullies. All those born between February 15 and August 10, 1961, are stately smooth talkers.

Or are they? George W & Bill Clinton were born 44 days apart. Both of them have the same prenatal eclipse at 7 Cancer. How can they possibly be the same?

Let's look deeper. A prenatal eclipse point is not a body, so it will cast no rays (conjunctions, though, are allowed), but it will have a house position & a dispositor. In both cases, the Moon.

In Bill's case, the prenatal eclipse point, 7 Cancer, is conjunct his MC. This might be why so many people thought he was a tyrant (I wasn't one of them). It is disposed by the Moon in Taurus in 8. Which is good for manipulating others, useful for a politician. In its turn, the Moon is disposed by Venus in Libra in the 1st (the most powerful planet in Clinton's chart), meaning that whatever he attempts he will be known for.

George W Bush is another story. His prenatal falls exactly on his 12th house cusp (Placidus, I never use anything else), so remains hidden. Its dispositor, the Moon, is approaching tight conjunction with Jupiter in Libra, and both of them are headed towards the 4th house cusp. Libra is the sign of warfare (does that surprise you?). The Moon there makes it personal, Jupiter makes it larger than life, the 4th house makes it a fundamental bedrock (the "war president" anyone?). These are disposed by Venus, now in Leo, which takes pride in being known (1st house) for what has been brought to it, in this case, conflict. Venus is disposed by the Sun in Cancer in 12, which, as Cancer is an emotional soup, takes secret (12th house) delight in the destruction that has been brought to it by this roundabout process. That Sun is disposed by the Moon, which makes for a closed loop. Watch out for people with those!

As **Martha** ceaselessly reminds us, a chart is true. No matter how you look at it.


**Your prenatal eclipse?** Find it in any good ephemeris. Remember to round up to the next degree. **DeVore** lists eclipses from 1800 to 2000, though as he truncates minutes, you will need to add a degree to his positions before you look them up in Sepharial.

## Part 3: The Moon in Elections

he Moon in the ascendant is very unfavorable for almost every thing, unless it is strong by sign & very well aspected. In fact it is wiser to avoid this position in all cases except when it is expressly stated to favour the particular matter in hand. If the Moon is in the ascendant with Saturn it denotes sorrow, long & tedious illness or death, loss of money, goods & friends, and trouble from influential people. If with Jupiter, it denotes journeys & voyages, but may bring marriage, children or other benefits. If with Mars, much harm & deception; if with Venus, it may bring health & gain through women; and if Mercury, many changes of work or friends. If both Sun & Moon are in the ascendant it is said to denote loss, trouble, sorrow, danger to the eyesight, and instability in the matter of the election....

t is considered evil to place Cauda in the ascendant, or in conjunction with either the Sun or Moon, especially at the time of New or Full Moon, possibly because it would also be an eclipse.... – Electional Astrology, by Vivian Robson, \$19.95

# I-2-3 RECTIFICATION

ast month I needed Evangeline Adams' chart. I got the place wrong, but there was no birth time, and I wanted that. So I rectified it to 2 pm, February 8, 1868. How did I do it?

& Moon, and any stelliums. Here's a rule: People are known by their domiant house. One dominant house is typical. Two you find on occasion. More than that is rare. That house will contain the Sun, or Moon, or stellium, or possibly the ruler of the ascendant.

This makes rectification similar to horary. In horary, we first establish the house that rules the question at hand. We do the same with rectification. Evangeline Adams was known for being intelligent. That's a 3rd house/9th house thing. As Miss Adams was a full moon birth, I could set the Sun in 9 & the Moon in 3. So I did.

Which put Cancer on the ascendant. Cancers are known for having big chests. I looked at the picture on the cover of **Christino**'s book & it looked chesty to me. I then noticed Venus in Pisces in 10, which would seem to account for her popularity. Neptune was further along in 10, which would be her fame on early radio. Moon, ruler of the ascendant in 3, and in Leo, Adams would be busy about town, a prominent person in her city of residence.

Consider also angular vs: cadent houses. Angular makes for aggressive people, according to the angle. Cadent are those who blow with the wind.

Et voilà: Adams rectified to 2 pm. Is this definitive? No. More work, more questions, will produce better results.

My brother & sister-in-law have just arrived. Both have Gemini rising but sis may be Cancer, as she has the moon face of a Cancer rising.

Dear CC,

Check also the sun/moon. Full moons have round faces. This is from **Penfield**, who looked at me & nailed mine at a glance.

- Bro-law-has has **Saturn on his Mars!** The in-laws always talk about how laid back he is as if it were a good thing but my husband says he has no initiative, no forward momentum, squashes every plan that anyone comes up with almost as a matter of course.

**Driving with the brakes on**, as **Oken** observed.

- It is little surprise that she rules the roost. I wondered about the **conjunct** ascendants. I guess that would make their outlook on life similar as there would be house cusps in common.

Conjunct ascendants/identical signs on house cusps mean they experience a lot of things in the same way. They also get hit with the same house-based transits at pretty much the same time, so their lives are often in sequence. For areas of harmony & conflict, look to house-based, mundane aspects. Is what's in her 4th house compatible with what's in his 4th house, for example. If one has Mars in 4 & the other has Saturn in 4, they're going to grate, even if there's no traditional aspect between them. If they're near the same age, then the outer planets should all fall in the same houses, which gives them a feeling of being in the foxhole together, facing the world as a team. Differences come from the relative house placements of Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter & Saturn. Houses, not sign to sign (or degree-based) aspects are what you're looking for. Robson gets into this. - Dave
