I'm itching to plug my compilation of Sapharial's books on **How to Make Money!**,

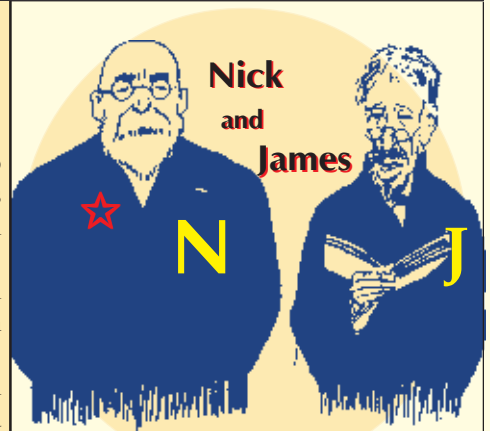

PART OF FORTUNE/Fortuna

James Wilson, 1819: The opinion of Placidus before he had seen that of **Negusan-tius**, was that the \oplus moved on the path of the \mathcal{D} 's latitude & he was right, if anything can be called right that is fundamentally wrong: for as the \odot , having no latitude, is always in the ecliptic, therefore uniform with the horoscope according to the course of the ecliptic, so the \mathcal{D} should be uniform with the \oplus according to the course of the ecliptic...

Nicholas deVore, 1947: Its symbol, a cross within a circle \oplus , is that used by astronomers to represent the Earth. It is the ancient Chinese symbol *Tien*, a field; used by the Egyptians to signify territory. It is generally considered that the house position of \oplus . . .

DENEbola beta Leonis 21 ♌ 45

Notes: A blue star in the Lion's tail. From Al Dhanab al Asad, the Tail of the Lion, or, according to Bullinger, the Judge, or Lord who Cometh. Frequently abbreviated to Deneb & so given in most astrological works, but this title properly belongs to another star already described.

Influence: According to Ptolemy it is of the nature of Saturn & Venus; to Wilson & Pearce, of Saturn, Venus & Mercury; to Simmonite, of Uranus; and, to Alvidas, of Mercury, Uranus & Mars. It gives swift judgment, despair, regrets, public disgrace, misfortune from the elements of nature, & happiness turned to anger, & makes its natives noble, daring, self-controlled, generous & busy with other people's affairs.

If rising: Riches, preferment & good fortune, attended by many dangers & anxieties through own folly, benefits seldom last...

IVY'S GEM OF THE WEEK

When Planets Change Direction

THE year in which a planet changes direction & turns either Direct or Retrograde is usually singled out for importance in the life. Whether in the past or future it is desirable to progress the chart for that year in order to account for what has already happened because of that planet's influence, or to see what is still to take place: either way, it will register very strongly.

Allowing for a lifetime of 90 years we go forward 90 days in the natal ephemeris for the PROGRESSED area, & we also go backward 90 days in the natal ephemeris for the PRE-NATAL area, remember that in either case we consider the developments to materialize during the 90 years AFTER birth.

The number of days before or after birth showing any planet marked either D or R (Direct or Retrograde) is taken as the number of years after birth & indicates the native's age thereby, for chart-progression.

USING Char #8 page 28, we note simply the birthdate Feb. 24, 1957.

Going forward 90 days we find no change during February, but Saturn turns R on March 23d which is 27 days after birth or 27 YEARS after, denoting the year 1984 for special significance. Uranus turns D on April 10, 45 days after birth or age 45. 2002 would therefore be worth progressing. Both Jupiter & Mercury turn D on May 19th at age 84, the year 2041. — from **Foundations of the Astrological Chart**, 1959.

Chapter 1 The first priority: Harmony

[continued from last month:]

IT is highly recommended that a minimum ratio of two harmonious aspects to one disharmonious aspect be present when comparing the planets of the two individuals involved (ten sextiles, trines, good conjunctions, and/or excellent 1st & 7th house placements in contrast to five squares).

The composite chart is discussed in Chapter 3 & is the "bottom line." If the composite chart is very harmonious, whereas the planetary chart comparison is not, there is a possibility the relationship can survive. The problems in the planetary comparison will not disappear, but will lessen with an excellent composite chart.

The above -mentioned ratio of harmonious-to-disharmonious aspects (two-to-one) is considered rock bottom for sustaining any union. Any proportion less than this bare minimum presents a challenge. The smaller the ratio of good-to-bad, the greater the challenge; i.e. a learning experience. Even when the matching of aspects reveals the two beneficial to one detrimental ratio required, there still exists a need for compromise on both sides for the merger to survive unless the ratio is wide, such as a four-to-one ratio of positive to negative aspects. When we find the ratio in a closer degree (i.e., ten sextiles, trines, and good conjunctions against seven squares), our relationship slowly deteriorates.

With the two-to-one harmony to disharmony prevailing, harmonious events happen at least two-thirds of the time, and disharmonious events happen not more than one-third of the time. This ratio is livable. When the proportion is less than two-to-one (eight good, eight bad, for instance), disagreeable actions surface more often. No sustaining relationship can take this barrage, and this type of relationship deteriorates more rapidly.

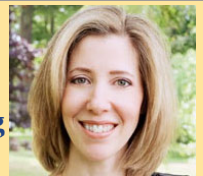
Void of Course Moon, aka the twilight zone

Part 24: *Cheap pleasures:*
Bathing

Let the Moon be in Libra or Pisces, and in good aspect to Venus, when bathing for pleasure or cleanliness. In taking medicinal baths consider the planet causing the illness. If it is Saturn, and the illness is of a cold or moist nature, let the Moon be in a fiery sign in good aspect with the Sun. If Mars is the cause of the illness, and it is of a hot or feverish nature, let the Moon be in a watery sign, in good aspect with Jupiter or Venus.

**Buying or Wearing
New Clothes**

Fortify the ascendant, its ruler & the Moon. Let the ascendant & the sign containing its ruler be cardinal, and if possible let the Moon be in Aries (except from the 7th to the 15th degrees, and 22° or 23°), or in the first 15 degrees of Libra, or the first 18 degrees of Virgo, or the first 19 degrees of Sagittarius, or the first 20 degrees of Pisces. The Moon may also be in the first 20 degrees of Taurus, for there it promises pleasure & satisfaction, but it should not be in any other fixed sign, especially Leo or Scorpio, the former being particularly evil for the purpose. ASTEROID OF THE MONTH
Ceres



[an eye-opener - Dave]
SEE Ceres primarily as issues that deal with the mother-child relationship (or variations thereof), the nature of that relationship & events that center on FOOD & "taking care of" (plants, animals & people) and "growing things" (including cysts & warts!). If the connection of Ceres with "food" is followed, it will be seen to indicate food preferences (ie., w/Venus, for sweets, w/Nep-tune for soft drinks, liquids & seafood, w/Hades, junk food, instances of disgust with food), events that deal with the planning or scheduling of meals (ie, = Cupido: family meals; = Jupiter or Kronos: gourmet food or foreign foods) and attitudes towards cooking, food preparation, shopping & grocery stores.

The symbology between the Mother-as-Nurturer and Food-as-Nurturing/Sustaining is profound. The attitudes toward food will be seen to mirror the nurturing & the relationship between the individual & his Mother or caretaker. Ceres indicates how well one feels protected, accepted, cared for and truly nurtured by his environment & the world, as well as does it show his individual NEED for protection & emotional connection.

Ceres also has a darker side (re: Demeter) and seems to play an important role in death charts & vindictive themes regarding children. Ceres can indicate an extended period of mourning & long term feelings of grief & loss.
