NEW NEWS

THE solstice was Wednesday, June 20, at 7:08 pm EDT. Here in the East Coast, Uranus is in the 4th, which means cool and windy. In Chicago, Mars is on the MC, which means hot, both these from **McCormack**.

REMEMBER the transit of Venus, retrograde, over the Sun's disk, on June 5? It was at 16-ish of Gemini. Jupiter makes a station there in September-October. Is this good? I dunno! Anything retrograde in Gemini is a liar on the face of it (us Geminis are only barely truthful on our best days!) Venus's rulership of Taurus, and Taurus's affinity with money make a retrograde Venus in Gemini a swindler. The memory of which is what Jupiter will be magnifying. The Sun will square it about September 16, and Mars will oppose it around the 30th of October.

Want more fun? The lunar eclipse was the day earlier, at 14 of Gemini-Sag, and will get hit by the same Jupiter-Mars-Sun combo. Mercury, too, around October 17.

WE'RE about to find out if a lunar eclipse, followed by a very rare Venus transit, have any delayed effects so far as mundane astrology is concerned. If they do, we're in for a really spectacular election season. No, not with guns. More likely, another financial disaster. There is already talk of another one, coming soon. Hang on to your money!

Notes: A brilliant white star in the left foot of the Southern Twin, often called the Bright Foot of Gemini. From Al Han'ah, a Brand or Mark burnt in.

Influence: According to Ptolemy it is of the nature of Mercury and Venus. It bestows eminence in art but gives liability to accidents affecting the feet.

IVY'S GEM OF THE WEEK

The Moon's General Indications

THE first aspect the Moon applies to reveals what to expect first: if good, a good start — and if her last aspect is also good, then a good ending to the matter. If the first aspect is bad and the last good, matters get off to a bad start but end well. When her final aspect is bad it signifies an unsatisfactory end of the matter.

If all her aspects are good, little trouble if any will be experienced; but if they are all bad there is great difficulty in the attempt and no final success.

If the Moon's final aspect is to a retrograde planet there will be frustration and the case will not turn out as planned; the person is at fault if it is his ruler.

If her final aspect is parallel but to a retrograde planet, the answer to the question is Yes; but not as expected; it is as good as done but will come too late to do any real good" as far as this case is concerned.

If the Moon's final aspect is a square, the querent will regret the course he took, and any request is sure to give offense, which will endure if that planet is a malefic in a Fixed Sign, particularly Scorpio. If the Moon's final aspect is an opposition, matters end with some separation or lack of cooperation; there is greed or jealousy in evidence, and especially if it is Saturn. — **Simplified Horary Astrology**, 1960, price \$42.35. **Order** a copy!

LUNAR MANSIONS

Special guest **Barak Obama**

IN the debate about Tropical and Sidereal, I used **Clint Eastwood's** natal chart to suggest that, so far as the twelve signs are concerned, there can be only one zodiac and it happens to be Tropical. Which reaffirmed my belief that the Tropical zodiac is in fact based on factors internal to the Earth itself. Not the sky. The Sidereal zodiac, based on twelve divisions of the sky, does not work.

But there is a Sidereal zodiac that does work, there is a system of signs that have always been given in Sidereal, and still are.

They are the Lunar Mansions. Which many of you have never heard of.

Lunar mansions are each equal to the distance the Moon travels in one day. How far is that? Go out the evening of the new moon, the first night you can see the thin sliver. Note its position in the evening glow.

Now go back out at the same time the next night. Note how much further into the sky the Moon moved in the space of one day. The Moon is in a much darker part of the sky. Has a thicker crescent. The difference, from one night to the next, is one day's travel. It is ONE LUNAR MANSION.

Keeping track of things by means of the Moon's daily travel is a very, very old system. It can be found in Arabic, Indian and Chinese flavors, which might all stem from a single source. It is also little understood.

Lunar mansions are so little understood there is dispute if there are 27 or 28 of them. The only book where I have found the Arabic mansions mentioned is in Robson's **Fixed Stars**, where he gives 28 and then enough information on their use in western magic for an imaginative Magus to make good use of them. Which I think he got from **Picatrix**.

In India, the lunar mansions are reasonably well-known as Nakshatras, and although there are 28 names, only 27 are commonly employed, the size of each Nakshatra being 13°20'. The only use made of them is in marriage compatibility, where the 27 mansions are reduced to animals and are then given genitalia. The Nakshatra of the groom's Moon (penis) is compared to the Nakshatra of the bride's Moon (vagina) and compatibility judged, in a technique known as Yoni Poruttham. If they are in compatible nakshatras, the couple will enjoy sex.

If not, they will not. It is said that in extreme cases of incompatibility, death may ensue from ordinary sexual coupling. I myself think this would never happen voluntarily, as the male and female in question would most likely abhor each other, but it can happen in cases of arranged marriages.

Which, one way or another, are still common in India and many other places in the world. In the arranged marriages which I myself have had a hand in, utmost consideration of the wishes of the bride and groom were given, but the final choice was still that of the respective parents. In this matter it would not be unusual for a strong-willed parent to overwhelm a weak or timid child, even if that child was 20 or 25 years old, resulting in a marriage partner that was unwanted and unloved. Before you rush to condemn this, remember that the western system, based on casual attraction, is far from foolproof.

As this will be new to most of you, I will give the standard table, taken from Defouw and Svoboda's **Light on Relationships**:

To use the table, set your chart in the Sidereal zodiac, Lahiri ayanamsha. From 0° Aries, count off 13°20' until you find your Moon. If you have a Vedic subroutine in your computer program, it should give the planetary nakshatras directly.

The term yoni refers to the female geni-

tals, whereas lingham refers to the male.

With these preliminaries out of the way, we can get down to business.

Just as a chart can be read for the signs occupied by the planets and ascendant, it can also be read for the Nakshatra of the planets and ascendant. The problem is that there is only one published text, so far as I know, that gives actual delineations for each of the planets in each of the 27 nakshatras.

Which is the purple volume of K.T. Shubhakaran's **Nakshatra** set. It is in hardcover and comes with the companion volume, on Vimshottari Dasas, a completely unrelated topic. The set is \$55.00, which is a lot. The publisher, Sagar, in Delhi, is among the more savvy and so I suspect the problem is the author, who seems to like his books as two-volume sets, and in hardcover to boot. I mention this as I am about to quote a good bit of it and if I'm successful a lot of you will want to have it.

ITURN now to our honored guest, the President of the United States, Barack Obama.

I am of the opinion that Barack Obama's birth chart, in the Tropical zodiac, does not fit him. So let's see if his chart, in Sidereal, gives a different view.

The following positions are in the **Sidereal zodiac, Lahiri ayanamsha**, which is roughly one degree in advance of the Fagan-Bradley ayanamsha.

24 degrees of Capricorn rises. This is the 24th Nakshatra, which is **Dhanishtha**. Here is Shubhakaran:

Physical features: The native has a lean body with lengthy figure. *Check.*

Character and general events: He will be expert in all the works he undertakes. He has extremely intelligent mind and alround knowledge. He does not like to cause any trouble to others. He always like to live with his own calibre and effort. He dislikes to express his disagreement with others til the last moment. *Check.*

Education, source of earnings, profession: Most of the scientists and historians are born in this Nakshatra. Since there is an inherent talent of keeping secret, the native is quite suitable for secret service, private secretaries to the senior executive. Whatever may be his academic background his intelligence is beyond questionable. [*Please excuse the author; he writes in Hinglish.*—Dave] In argument also he is much ahead of others. Hence lawyers profession is best for him. Normally, period from 24th years of age onwards [1985] will show progress in



the earning field. Since he will be engaged in the profession or trade where he has to trust others, he should be very very careful before putting trust on others. **Check!**

Family life: His relatives will cause a lot of embarrassment and problems. He is more inclined to his brothers and sisters. He will have ample inherited property subject to the placement of planets in beneficial position. He cannot have much benefit from his in-laws. But this drawback will be nullified due to the presence of good qualities in his wife. His wife will be an incarnation of "Laxmi" (goddess of wealth). To be more specific, any improvement in the financial field of the native will be only after marriage. *To which I say, if you understand what the author is talking about, Check.*

Health: His health may not be so good. Even then he will not think about his own health. It is only when the disease reaches at the peak he starts finding remedy. Slightest improvement out of the several disease will drag him to the work field. He is prone to whooping cough, anaemia, etc. However he will not be on a prolonged state of illness. *Unknown.*

That's Shubhakaran's take on Obama's ascendant. On balance, **a phenomenally good fit.** This is as far as I got before I started writing these notes. I literally do not know what comes next, so let's continue.

Obama's Sun, Lahiri ayanamsha, is at 19° Cancer. That's No. 9, Ashlesha

Shubhakaran starts with aspects to the Sun. **Vedic aspects** are nothing like western aspects, and my understanding of Vedic astrology is weak generally. However,

Jupiter aspects, the native is respected in his family circle, always dependent on the government for his wealth. *Check.* Obama has for many years been employed by one government or other.

Obama's Sun is aspected by Saturn, which means he will suffer from jaundice, will be paralyzed and poor. *No.*

You will not believe what comes next. Each of these 13°20' sections are *quartered*, and each quarter given a specific delineation. These are known as *padhas*. Obama's Sun is in the first padha. Regrettably, the delineation refers to an ascendant in some other Nakshatra and so cannot be used. Overall, the delineation of Obama's Sun is *weak*, as it has only his status as a government employee to support it, while Saturn contradicts.

Obama's Moon is at 10° of Taurus, which puts it at the very beginning of Rohini, the fourth Nakshatra. Rohini means red cow.

Obama's Moon is in aspect to Jupiter, which means he respects his parents and discharges his responsibilities to them. *Check.*

Obama's Moon is not in aspect to Saturn. If they were in aspect, the native loses his mother early and will not get any benefit from his father. Which, I regret to say, is **true**, which means that if Obama's Moon is

in Rohini, it *should be* in aspect to Saturn.

In the first padha, Obama's Moon gives him pleasant manners, lovely appearance, sweet tongue, many brothers and sisters, good going at business. *Check*.

On balance, Obama's Moon is *mixed*.

Obama's Mercury is at 9° Cancer, which is in the 8th Nakshatra, Pushya.

Obama's Mercury is aspected by his Sun, as both are in the same Sidereal sign. This gives a mixed type of job, depending on other planetary combinations. *Check*.

Jupiter aspects: Highly learned in various sciences and sastras and look after the welfare of rulers and acquires wealth through them. *Mixed*.

Saturn aspects: Devoid of virtues, does not maintain good relations with his brothers and sisters and is discarded by his own wife and children. *Mixed*.

Mercury is in the second padha: The native will occupy a position where maximum trust is required i.e. Private Secretaries, Secret Agents or in Vigilance, Security departments. His lungs may be affected. *Mixed*. Obama smokes, though he hides it. And I would like to see something better than private confidante.

On balance, Obama's Mercury is *mixed*.

Obama's Venus is at 8° Gemini. This is Nakshatra 6, Ardra. So far as I can tell, Obama's Venus has no aspects in the Vedic system.

Venus is in the first padha. Male native will have his education in the scientific field. He may also be interested in music and arts. *No*.

On balance, Venus is *inconclusive*, but veers towards failing.

Obama's Mars is at Uttara Phalguni, no. 12. Shubhakaran says Martian aspects in the 12th Nakshatra are the same as those of the 6th Nakshatra, Ardra.

Obama's Mars is in the first padha and has no aspects. Shubhakaran has a specific note on that: Mars without any association or aspect makes the native poor, enduring, travelling in forests and has few children and a good wife.

On balance, **Obama's Mars fails.** He has never been poor, nor homeless. He has two daughters, which, in modern America, makes him average.

Obama's Jupiter is at 7° of Capricorn. It, as well as his Saturn, is in the 21st Nakshatra, Uttara Ashadha. For aspects, Shubhakaran directs us to the 19th Nakshatra, Mula.

Obama's Jupiter is aspected by his Sun: The native is poor, disliked by all. *No*.

Obama's Jupiter is aspected by his Moon: Very fortunate position, will enjoy good family life with abundant money and comforts. *Maybe*. Shubhakaran is not describing the life of a wandering politician.

Obama's Jupiter is aspected by his Saturn: The native has a tendency to steel [sic] things and will be forsaken by his village men. *No*.

Obama's Jupiter is in aspect to his Mercury: A minister or equivalent. *Check*.

Obama's Jupiter is in the 4th padha. The text for this is given under the 22nd Nakshatra, Abhijit. Jupiter becomes more powerful even though he is debilitated by sign (Capricorn). Jupiter nullifies all other evil effects. He attains top position in the government, may be minister or a governor or an administrator.

On balance, *Check*.

Obama's Saturn is at 2° Capricorn, and, as Jupiter, in the 21st Nakshatra, Uttara Ashadha. For aspects we are again referred to the 19th Nakshatra:

Obama's Saturn is in aspect to his Sun: If Saturn in this Nakshatra is aspected by the Sun, fairly good position comparing to Sun's aspect to Saturn placed in other nakshatras, the native will enjoy gods pleasure i.e. name, fame and wealth. *Check*.

Obama's Saturn is in aspect to Mercury: Enjoys a very high reputation and be equal to a minister in rank. *Check*.

Obama's Saturn is in the 2nd padha. The native will frequently change his profession. His wife will be sickly. Will incur heavy financial losses. A perturbed mind. *No*.

On balance, Obama's Saturn is *mixed*.

Obama's North Node, Rahu, is at 4° Leo. It is in the 10th Nakshatra, second padha of Magha: Rahu alone will confer self-earning through unlawful activities. Presuming we agree this is Obama's chart, *No*. Rahu fails.

Obama's South Node, Ketu, is at 4° Aquarius. It is in the 4th padha of the 24th Nakshatra, Dhanishtha. Of that, Shubhakaran says, somewhat better than the third padha, which inclines people to steal from your house. The fourth padha gives a government job and a child who will become famous and wealthy. Since a president's children normally do well, *Check*.

Shubhakaran does not give results for Uranus, Neptune and Pluto.

SUMMARY

ON balance, with Obama's chart we have a spectacular fit with his ascendant, with indifferent or poor

results for Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars and Rahu.

Ketu and Saturn generally check as accurate.

Jupiter makes Obama who he is. Shubhakaran says this one factor makes him a success, and I am in no position to dispute him.

Nakshatras confirm Barack Obama to be who he claims to be.
