Spine and Back. Spinal curvature and allied troubles are nearly always characterized by afflictions in the fixed signs, and especially in and near 19° Leo-Aquarius, also afflictions often fall near 23° mutables. Saturn and Uranus are very frequently the afflicting planets.

Example: Male, born in Northants, midnight, October 24-25, 1837, Asc 20° Leo square Saturn, Moon opposition Uranus Virgo-Pisces.

Spiritualism, Attraction towards. This is one of the interests connected with the watery element and the corresponding planets and houses. The scientific investigator into phenomenon will usually have Uranus strong and very likely the Mercurial signs and Scorpio. Cancer and Pisces are probably the commonest ascendants, both among mediums and the rank and file of their followers, and it is probable that Mercury will often be found in these signs. 
With Sun: Trouble through opposite sex, disappointments in expectations but otherwise favourable.

Your Personal Jupiter

THE idea is to recognize his promise and capacity in your chart, to evaluate it according to his position and strength by Sign, decanate and house, and relationship to the ascendant, its ruler or planet in the 1st House because the more he takes part in your life by activating your chart the more Jupiterian you life is to be.

You must appreciate too that some of his largess is lessened if his hands are tied by being retrograde, or intercepted and simultaneously afflicted by Saturn who limits freedom to operate outwardly; or badly aspected to the rising degree or its ruler or any planet in the 1st House, revealing a lack of awareness on your part, sometimes due to circumstances denying an opportunity. Where you have Saturn, Mars and Neptune you shall have problems and with Uranus you have a heavy cross to bear, always involving the matters of the house they are in.

On the other hand, just as the Sun illuminates whatever house he is in at birth, and Venus shows by house the department of life where you are affectionately received, the mere presence of Jupiter blesses the house he is in and its affairs in your behalf: you are never entirely bereft, for where he is, there you have help. He represents the Deity granting you some saving grace and if we truly seek it confidently we shall find some.

Strangely enough, if natal Jupiter and Sun are trine your Jupiter will be retrograde for life while waiting for the next Sun-Jupiter trine to release him which by progression in the ephemeris is 120 days (years). — **As-trological Essays**, 1979. **Buy.**

The Sky is Empty

Nothing comes from nothing. The zodiac is made up of the elements of Fire, Earth, Air and Water. None of these are present in the sky. All are present in the Earth.

Nothing comes from nothing. Each of the twelve signs of the zodiac is qualified by one of three states, Cardinal, Fixed, or Mutable. **These are states of energy:**

The quality of *having energy* is cardinal.

The quality of *resisting energy* is fixed.

The quality of *seeking energy* is mutable.

The sky is devoid of all forms of energy. The earth has all three. Therefore,

The Zodiac is of the Earth

The zodiac represents the twelve basic energetic states of the Earth. As such, the zodiac is not a circle, but a grid of three energies mapped against four elements. There are exactly twelve possibilities, there cannot be 11 or 13. *This grid represents the greatest possible simplification, the greatest reduction, of the whole of creation itself.* Understanding the interplay of elements and energies is therefore fundamental to understanding life upon the Earth, and is a prerequisite in all studies of the material world. Here is the fundamental grid:

	Energy/has (Cardinal)	Resists (Fixed)	Seeks (Mutable)

Water	Cancer	Scorpio	Pisces

The names given to these combinations are traditional. We can call them anything we like. The quality of resisting energy, which is traditionally known as fixed, can as easily be termed, **stagnant**. Hence, Scorpio, being fixed or resisting water, can also be called *stagnant water*, which has long been known to be intense and dangerous. Sagittarius, which is known as mutable fire, can also be termed, *sparks seeking to start a blaze*.

This was conceived by man or given by the gods (your choice) and was then projected into the sky a very long time ago. Which was then forgotten, leading to the long-standing belief that the zodiac is external, not internal. From a close reading of Vettius Valens (2nd century AD), it is clear the Greeks were not inventing or discovering astrology, so much as *recovering it*. Valens had concrete

values for houses but lacked all means of actually calculating them. If the Greeks were inventing or discovering astrology, this would be a fundamental paradox.

Earth as Automaton

If the Earth was isolated in the sky, these twelve qualities would be *dormant*. It is the interaction of the Earth with the Sun, Moon and other planets which sets these various energies into motion. Realize the Earth is more than big enough, and more than close enough to the other planets, to have exactly this kind of interaction, which it then radiates outwards from the center. **The signs of the zodiac are the inherent vibrations of the Earth itself.**

These interactions are made possible by the crystalline nature of the planets, and, I presume of the Sun itself. Researchers Lars Stixrude, of the University of London, and Ronald Cohen, of the Carnegie Institute of Washington, D.C., have speculated the core of the Earth to be a single gigantic **iron crystal**. They have further speculated that crystal to be six-sided. Read for yourself. Six relates to the zodiac, in that there are six faces and six edges, six “male” signs and six “female.” Confirming twelve overall. I feel sorry for Stixrude and Cohen. They are about to be run out of the scientific community, the fate of all **researchers** who accidentally hit upon the nature of astrology.

Many meteorites have been found to contain the metal **hexahedrite**, which is a six-sided crystalline form of iron. Meteorites are known to be the busted-up remains of dead planets. It is therefore likely that if the Earth has a crystalline core, so do all other planets as well. Additionally, the Earth has a crystal covering, which is water. Water forms six-sided crystals when frozen, mimicking the central crystal. The six-sided crystal is inherent.

THE Earth's zodiac is organized around the alignment of the Earth's central crystal with the Sun's presumed central crystal. (The core of the Sun is not nuclear, an argument I have made **elsewhere**.) These alignments happen at the *solstices* and *equinoxes*. We have thus established the **Tropical Zodiac** as an objective, scientific, fact. The zodiac shows the relationship of the Earth to the Sun. (The Side-

The Alphabet of Astrology *continued:—*

Mars. Hot, dry, barren, inflammatory, positive, electric, energetic, warlike and quarrelsome. It was called the Lesser Infortune and is usually unfavourable, tending to accidents, wars, quarrels, fires and passions.

Jupiter. Warm, moist, fruitful, positive and electric. It was called the Greater Fortune and its influence is benevolent, charitable, jovial and expansive.

Saturn. Cold, dry, barren, melancholy, negative and magnetic. It is the Greater Infortune and its influence is separative, secretive, apprehensive, suspicious, selfish, cold and chaste.

Uranus. Cold, dry, barren, positive and electric. It is eccentric, explosive, spasmodic, original, erratic, separative and tends to accentuate the will and individuality.

Neptune. Warm, moist, fruitful, negative and magnetic. Its influence is chaotic, dreamy, fanciful, psychic, spiritual, deceptive and tends to sacrifice or self-suppression.

These influences are general and are exerted in every department of life, being modified by signs and houses, and their application in particular cases will be explained later. The use of the terms "benefic" and "malefic" is a convenience. The nature of a planet is neither good nor bad, and the question of fortunate or unfortunate influences depends upon the planet's position and aspects in the horoscope. It is important to remember that a malefic will produce good if well-aspected, and a benefic will proe unfortunate if badly aspected. There is, however, probably more sympathy between conditions of life here and the nature of the benefic planets, for while a badly aspected malefic will produce serious evils, a benefic in a similar condition will not be so strongly and violently evil. — **A Student's Text-Book of Astrology**, by Vivian Robson. Anatomical Rulerships

LEO represents the heart of the physical organism. It is significant of vital power, ardency, interchange and generation. *Sol et homo generant hominem*, for this is the solar sign, and equivalent to the fifth house of nativity, which is later concerned with offspring. The spinal column with its marrow and nerves is also under the rule of this sign. The sphere of Leo is thus a vital, extensive and deep-seated one.

Principle bones: Dorsal vertebrae

Muscles: Longissimus and latissimus dorsi, transversalis, interspinalis.

Arteries: Aorta, anterior and posterior coronary arteries.

Veins: Vena cavae, coronaries.

Morbid Action: Heart disease of various forms, palpitation, syncope, fevers, spinal meningitis, locomotor ataxy, aneurism, angina pectoris.

Virgo

This, the second of the common signs, is nervous and rather barren in quality. It is associated with the bowels, and chiefly with the duodenum, jejunum and ileum, for Virgo is concerned with chylification just as Cancer is with chymification. Absorption and assimilation, selection and utilization are the Virgo functions. The preparation and absorption of the **chyle** is often much interfered with in persons belonging to this sign, or having one of the luminaries afflicted herein. It is greatly affinitized with hygiene, diet and sanitation. Other parts of the body under this government are the mesentery, peritoneum, spleen and sympathetic nervous system.

Principle bones: Lumbar vertebrae

Muscles: Quadrati lumborum, sacro-lumbares, etc.

Arteries: Suprarenal, renal, lumbar.

A Brief History of Astrometeorology

THE first known work on weather and the atmosphere was The Meteorologica by the Greek philosopher-scientist Aristotle (384 BC to 322 BC). His pupil, Theophrastus expanded this early treatise in two works "On Winds" and "On the Signs of Rain, Winds, Storms and Fair Weather."

These were the sole authorities on meteorology until scientific investigations began in the 17th century. (Ptolemy's Tetrabiblos, 152 AD quoted brief excerpts).

In 1686, Dr. J. Goad's Astro-Meteorologica, based on 39 years of his own astro-weather observations and correlations was published in London. Until the end of the 19th Century this text was the leading authority on the subject. It includes a transcript of astronomer Johannes Kepler's diary of astro-weather observations from June 28, 1617 to August 9, 1629. Here Kepler expounded some of his theories relating planetary phenomena to atmospheric changes. It is a matter of historical record that he attained recognition for his remarkably accurate long-range weather forecasting long before advancing his laws of planetary motion. Kepler's "Mysterium Cosmographicum" is a fully documented record of his work from 1602 to 1629. Some scientists who have written disparagingly of the renowned Kepler's interest in correlating planetary phenomena to terrestrial events have rendered a disservice to the progress of science.

real Zodiac is based on the Earth's wobble, which is itself an artifact of solar and lunar gravities. It functions as a chronocrator and is used as such by all sidereal-based astrologies.)

Planets in the sky are tagged by the Earth with the qualities of the signs in which they appear to be, since it is the Earth which generates those sign energies, presumably as literal extensions in space of the central crystal's facets. Which gives the Earth twelve pairs of "rose colored glasses," if you will. It is the Earth that assigns Aries to one part of the sky, Leo to another. It is the Earth's 12-sided (duodenary) nature that explains the traditional Ptolemaic aspects, which are facet-to-facet, edge-to-edge, and facet-to-edge phenomena. Neither signs, nor aspects, nor houses, apply to stars because they are outside the area of interactive planetary crystals that comprise the solar system.

Houses are produced by the daily turning of the Earth's crystal on its axis. **The crystal is thus the single source for signs, houses and aspects.** The northern and southern ends of this gigantic crystal are known as the Earth's magnetic poles.

The Earth's crystal, and therefore the Earth as a whole, vibrates according to the relative positions of Sun, Moon and planets. Each planet has a natural affinity for some parts of the Earth and not others. We term the parts of the Earth that resonate best to Mercury to be mutable air and mutable earth, in other words, Gemini and Virgo. When we put the zodiac in the Earth, rather than the sky, we understand how a planet in one sign can be said to rule a planet in some other, for instead of jumping about in an empty sky, we are merely describing the internal workings of the Earth's crystal.

Birth

SINCE the Earth is vibrating, everything on the Earth is vibrating in sympathy with it. So whenever anything on Earth divides or breaks in two, the existing vibration of the smaller part will tend to be replaced by the Earth's current vibration as of that moment. This, in fact, is strict physics. When a child is born it loses its mother's vibration and takes on the Earth's vibration. Because of her greater mass, the mother's vibration changes, but only somewhat. She has a significant transit.

By comparison, a plant, because it grows as part of the earth and is in vibrational harmony with it, does not experience "birth" until it is cut, or harvested. Because plants grow in harmony with the Earth, plants can produce ideal planetary prototypes, in other words, plants that tightly express the values

of one or more planets because they are tightly ruled by them. Which accounts for their essential use in healing, since disease can be defined as a simple mal-adjustment to planetary vibrations. Minerals and gems have the same qualities for the same reason.

Birth vibrations age over time, as all vibrations must. As there are many levels of vibration (the Earth is a huge mass) astrology knows this aging process by many names, among them, primary directions, secondary progressions, solar arcs, Vimshottari dasas, Yogini dasas, etc. When aged vibration matches up with current planetary placements (transits), a significant event can occur. When transient vibrations are greater than the individual can withstand, death ensues.

Objections: 1. Gravity

IT IS clear that as the human body is made up of the elements of the Earth, that various regions of the body will be ruled by the various signs, which will then be influenced by the casual placement of the planets to which they have an affinity. It is not true that Mars directly affects me, but it is true that as my body is made up of elements that are influenced by Mars, that the Earth's response to changes in the relative position of Mars will produce appropriate responses in those Earth-based Martian elements in me.

Objections: 2. Distance

Planetary energies in fact adhere closely to the inverse square law. The Sun, due to its staggering size, and the Moon, due to its sheer proximity, are the primary influences in our lives. *They are unvarying*, as their distances never change.

Mercury, Venus and Mars provide *personal details*. Which fluctuate, as they come and go.

Jupiter and Saturn, much further away, are known as *social planets*, as they provide background.

The outer planets, the Uranians, the asteroids, effect us to the extent they make tight aspects to closer bodies.

Objections: 3. Repeatability

Nor is the doctrine of "falsifiability" a valid objection. Astrology is falsifiable in the same way a trip in a car is falsifiable, as both deal with *time*. The same car, the same driver, the same route, but no two trips can ever be alike. Every trip, every individual, is unique in time.

Astrology and Science

None of this will satisfy science, which will remain hostile to astrology by reason of its very existence. Science, which admits of no external limits ("we alone know what is

true and what is false") is in fact highly sensitive to overall social mores. In racist societies, science finds justification for racism, up to and including **sterilization** and euthanasia. In materialistic societies, science finds justification for materialism. In warlike societies, science builds bombs. In unequal societies, science justifies inequality.

Reading Wiki's page on the **Scientific Method** we learn that science is whatever scientists say it is, and that the methods used are whatever is convenient.

Every society has the science it deserves. Science, believing itself to be absolute, attacks whatever would limit its power and authority, without regard for any other factor. Hence its fear of religion and astrology, both of which, wretched though they are, are superior to it.

Without external, guiding principles, science is Eve's apple (from the Tree of Knowledge), sent to seduce Adam. *Wouldn't you like to know the secret? Wouldn't you like to be God Himself? It's easy. Just take a bite and follow these simple instructions.* Astrology, with its foundations now clearly revealed (elements and energies) are the universal guiding principles. Astrology captures the structure of creation itself, which in the interplay of twelve basic energies, is more complex than observational science can ever know.

Conclusion:

YOU can wait for forecasters to guess at the weather, or you can get an ephemeris and study the raw energies. With astrology you may predict weather as far in advance as you like. Or anything else. With astrology you may know the fate of the planet itself.

Astrology is the study of the Earth. How the Earth relates to the Sun, Moon and planets, and what that means to the creatures that crawl on its surface. Astrology is the one fundamental science, underlying all others.


